Mah Jong Cards

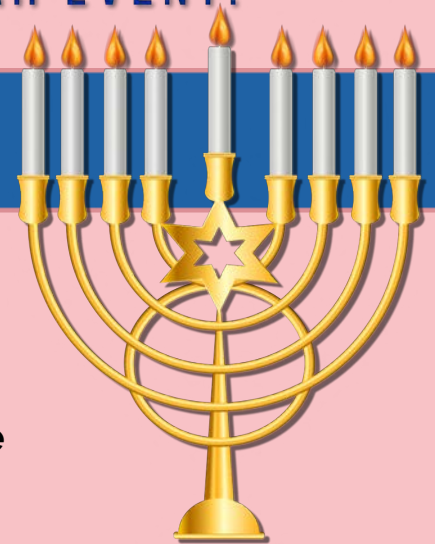

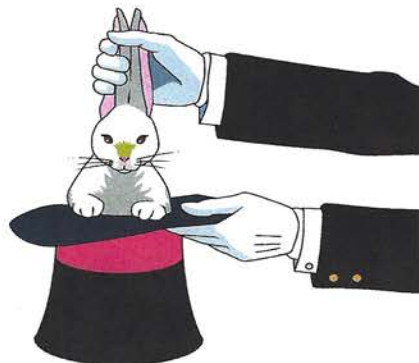
